**ORDER FOR CONTINUING
MEDICAL EDUCATION**

(NON-DISCIPLINARY)

At its public meeting on February 23, 2011, the Arizona Regulatory Board of Physician Assistants ("Board") voted to issue Michele Ansorge, P.A.. ("Physician Assistant") a non-disciplinary Continuing Medical Education (CME) Order for failure to repeat an EKG and cardiac enzymes in a patient with chest pain, and for inadequate medical records in violation of A.R.S. § § 32-2501(18)(j) and 32-2501(p). The Board ordered Physician Assistant to complete 10-15 hours hours of Board staff pre-approved Category I non-disciplinary CME in acute cardiac disease, including acute coronary syndrome, within six months pursuant to A.R.S. §32-2551(D)(3). The CME hours shall be in addition to the hours required for the biennial renewal of medical licensure. This matter does not rise to the level of discipline.


ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Physician Assistant shall, within six months, complete 10-15 hours of Board Staff pre-approved Category I Continuing Medical Education ("CME") in acute cardiac disease, including acute coronary syndrome, and provide Board Staff with satisfactory proof of attendance. The CME hours shall be in addition to the hours required for biennial renewal of her medical license. Physician Assistant's' failure to complete the CME will subject her to future disciplinary action by the Board. A.R.S. § 32-2501(18)(k).

RIGHT TO APPEAL

1 **NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that, pursuant to A.R.S. § 41-1092.03, any person
2 aggrieved by this decision may apply to the Board, in writing, within thirty (30) days of
3 receipt and request a public hearing with respect to this order. You may request a
4 hearing by filing a notice of appeal. The notice of appeal must be filed with the Board's
5 Executive Director, and should include your name, address, the action being appealed,
6 and a concise statement of the reasons for the appeal. If you request a public hearing,
7 the hearing will be scheduled within sixty (60) days of receipt of your request. If you
8 request a public hearing, you also have the right to request an informal settlement
9 conference by filing a written request with the Board, pursuant to A.R.S. § 41-1092.06, no
10 later than twenty (20) days before the scheduled hearing. The conference will be held
11 within fifteen (15) days after receipt of your request. Please note that you waive any right
12 to object to the participation of the Board's representative in the final administrative
13 decision of the matter if it is not settled at the conference.
